The point is simple:

In the walk through life there are many voices that try to tell us what we should do and the consequences can be confusing, even dangerous.

On this feast of Christ the King, if we choose Jesus as our guide through life he won't shout instructions at us from a safe distance but will get beside us and guide us safely and securely through life.

The conversation between Jesus and Pilate shows that Jesus' rule wasn't the absolute rule of a 1st century monarch, but the call on people to be disciples!

The imagery from Revelation leaves us in no doubt as to Jesus authority - but he chooses to be there for us!
